**“Siberia in a Global Context: The Environment and Local
Communities in a period of rapidly changing climate”**

October 1–6, 2019, Tomsk



The Tomsk State University together with the Tomsk Regional Administration, the Regional Committee for Environmental Protection and Nature Management, the Ugra State University (Khanty-Mansiysk) and the Institute for Water and Ecology Problems of the Siberian Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences (Barnaul), holds the fourth annual interdisciplinary workshop of the Siberian Environmental Change Network (SecNet).



The aim of the workshop is to explore the interaction between the global environmental challenges and local impacts, including those on Society. The workshop focuses on the following themes:

- 1. Life-support issues – environment and ecology: local problems of global importance.**
- 2. Social communities in the context of rapid environmental changes: perception and adaptation to changes in wildlife and ecosystems.**



The format of the workshop consists of short introductions and presentation followed by targeted discussions. A poster session is planned and local excursion around Tomsk will be organized.



A publication in a special issue of the Network Journal “Environmental Dynamics and Global Climate Change” is expected.
